is providing a unique opportunity to receive free training as a prisoner advocate.

Who we are: PAN is a network of California activists, family members, formerly incarcerated people, legal workers, law students and attorneys who support people housed in solitary confinement and similar conditions of isolation such as security housing units (SHUs), administrative segregation, and gender-based segregation. We prioritize advocating for jailhouse lawyers and those engaged in political activity.

What we do: Provide non-litigation advocacy for incarcerated people experiencing discrimination, retaliation, and rights violations. Gather evidence documenting conditions and trends of treatment in the exceptionally repressive prison environments of solitary and other forms of segregation.
