54010.18 Funds Enclosed in Correspondence

Stamps shall not be used as a form of currency under any circumstances. If it is discovered that an inmate is attempting to use stamps to purchase something either through the mail or otherwise, all stamps utilized for the transaction will be considered contraband. Contraband, per Title 15, will be confiscated and should result in disciplinary action.

Inmates discovered to be using stamps to purchase items through the mail will receive a CDC-1819 Notification of Disapproval – Mail/Packages/Publication stating stamps cannot be used as currency and the stamps will be sent home at the inmate's expense.

Inmates found to be in the possession of more than forty (40) stamps shall receive progressive discipline. Subsequent violations will result in the issuance of Rule Violation Reports.
