

KVSP DRESS CODE

Although it is not possible to provide an exhaustive list of all types of inappropriate business attire, the following are some examples considered non-business like attire:

- Blue denim clothing, blue chambray shirts, orange and lime green jumpsuits shall not be worn. Staff will review and consider the apparel worn in its entirety when determining it's similarity to inmate attire. Questionable attire shall be evaluated on a case by case basis by the area Supervisor.
- Blue, gray or acid washed denim clothing.
- Yellow rain coats shall not be worn. Umbrellas with protruding tips shall not be allowed.
- Shorts (including Bermuda shorts and biking pants), sweat suits, jogging suits or gym clothing shall not be worn on duty or on institutional grounds except by the Institutional Recreation and Physical Education Teachers (Coach), and staff attending special events or In-Service Training classes which require athletic attire. Capri pants will be allowed as long as they fall below the knee.
- Dresses, skirts, culottes or skorts, shall be no more than two inches above the top of the kneecap. Conservative judgment is to be exercised on clothing with slits or vents.
- Clothing and hats imprinted with offensive phrases or graphics are not permitted.
- Strapless tops (i.e. tube tops, halter tops, tank tops, etc.) are not permitted. Sheer fabrics shall not be worn.
- Leggings or tights worn as outer garments are not permitted.
- All clothing and footwear shall be appropriate for the work environment and what would be necessary to ensure the employee's safety.
- Clothing exposing the midriff area
- Flip-flop/shower shoes
- Sports attire: clothing with sports team logos such as jerseys, hats, T-shirts, etc are not authorized without prior approval from the Warden.
