SUBJECT: CONTRACT WITH THE UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE

Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Sheriff, or his designee, to sign a contract with the United States Marshals Service (USMS) to provide inmate bed space at the Santa Rita Jail (SRJ) and the Glenn E. Dyer Detention Facility (GEDDF) for the additional population of federal prisoners designated to the San Jose Federal Courthouse at a daily per diem rate of \$136 for the contract period 4/1/2017 – 3/31/2019.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:


On November 1, 1991, the United States Marshals Service (USMS) and Alameda County Sheriff's Office (ACSO), entered into agreements that allow the USMS to house federal detainees at the Santa Rita Jail and the Glenn E. Dyer Detention Facility. This population includes individuals charged with federal offenses, who are detained while awaiting trial, as well as individuals who have been sentenced and are awaiting designation and transport to a Bureau of Prisons facility.

The United States Marshals Service has agreed to a fixed per-day rate of \$136 specifically for those federal prisoners designated to the San Jose Federal Courthouse. The per-day rate for other federal prisoners will remain at \$122 as agreed to in a contract extension with the USMS through September 20, 2018, which was approved by your Board on October 11, 2016. If necessary, a re-determined price will be issued by the U.S. Department of Justice as a unilateral modification, no later than 15 days prior to the end of the period.

FINANCING:

The additional anticipated revenue is included in the Sheriff's Office FY 2017-18 approved budget. This request will not impact the net County cost in FY 2017-18 or subsequent years.
