

Estimated FOIA Production Based on June Email Production Rate

The tables titled *Estimated FOIA Production Based on 80,000 Pages* provides a projection of how long it would take the BOP to process its estimated 80,000 pages of email (the only item out of 50 items for which BOP provided a page estimate) if it continues at the same pace and using the same review and release criteria as the June 30, 2025 and July 31, 2025 productions.

Applying those same proportions to the 80,000-page estimate provided for email, and assuming BOP continues to review (as opposed to produce) 1,000 pages per month, it would take approximately 6 years and 8 months (80 months) for the agency to complete its review of email alone. For reference, the parties agreement regarding email (originally proposed by BOP) stated: (1) 5 custodians whose emails would be searched: Warden, Associate Warden, Executive Assistant of Dublin, Deputy Director, Regional Deputy Director of Western Region; (2) Date range: April 1 2023 - Jul 1, 2024 (3) Terms: transfer or closure or release, appearing in the same message as Dublin.

Production Rate Projection

In the **June 30, 2025**, production The BOP communicated it reviewed 674 pages of what appear to be emails. Out of those, only 2 pages were released in full (0.30%), 41 pages were released in part (6.08%), 11 pages were withheld in full (1.63%), 28 pages were deemed duplicative (4.15%), and a staggering 592 pages representing **87.83%** of the entire production, it deemed as non-responsive without explaining its criteria. The estimated results would be as follows:

- The total number of pages that would be either released in full, released in part, is only 5,103 (6.38%) (Only approximately 237 pages would be released in full)(4,866 pages would be released in part)
- 1,305 pages would be withheld in full (1.38%)
- 3,323 pages would be marked duplicative, (4.15%) Plaintiff requested that these be eliminated at the outset and not count towards monthly page quota.
- Over 70,000 pages (**87%**) labeled non-responsive and withheld entirely.

Based on the **July 31, 2024**, production the estimated results would indicate that a staggering **94.8%** of the entire production would be deemed as non-responsive without explaining its criteria:

- None released in full.
- Released in Part 2,560 (3.2%)
- Duplicative 1,600 (2.0%)
- Non-Responsive 75,840 (**94.8%**)
