Dear Ms. Henry:

This is in response to the above referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records in several categories concerning the Federal Prison Camp in Dublin, California (FCI Dublin).

In response to Item 9, a portion of Item 11 and the remainder of Item 47 of your request wherein you seek records concerning detainer information, property claims and staffing reports, staff located 650 pages of responsive records, which were forwarded to this office for a release determination. After careful review, 37 pages are appropriate for release in full and 613 pages are appropriate for release in part. Copies of the releasable records are attached.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, records were redacted under the following exemptions:

- (b)(6) - concerns material the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of third parties;
- (b)(7)(C) - concerns records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of third parties; and
- (b)(7)(F), permits withholding of records when endangering the safety or life of any individual could reasonably be expected.

The BOP considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing responsive records and applying FOIA exemptions.
