CHAPTER: Intake, Transfer, Release and Records	SUBJECT: Issuing Blankets in Intake, Transfer and Release	

- I. **PURPOSE:** To establish procedure for issuing blankets to new arrestees in ITR.
- II. **POLICY:** All newly arriving inmates who are insufficiently dressed for climatic conditions will be issued one blanket or jail issued clothing upon request.
- III. **DEFINITION:** INSUFFICIENTLY DRESSED: Clothing that does not cover one's arms or legs sufficiently to provide warmth for climatic conditions.
- IV. **PROCEDURE:**
 - A. Clean and sanitary blankets will be stored in the ITR male clothing storage area. ITR deputies assigned to Intake will be responsible for maintaining a minimum inventory of ten clean blankets for distribution.
 - B. Staff will provide insufficiently dressed inmates a blanket or jail issued clothing upon request.
 1. If possible, the inmate receiving a blanket will be placed in a holding cell by him/herself.
 2. When the inmate is released, the soiled blanket or jail issued clothing shall be removed from the cell and placed in the dirty clothing exchange cart for return to the laundry.
