<b>CHAPTER:</b> Intake, Transfer, Release and Records	<b>SUBJECT:</b> Inmate Disposition Identifiers (Facility and Hazard Flags)	

- I. **PURPOSE:** To readily identify the housing facility to which an inmate is assigned and identify inmates who require special handling.
  
- II. **POLICY:** ITR personnel will affix an appropriately assigned 3/4" diameter Avery brand, adhesive color dot to the face of the upper right hand corner in the area marked "Billet" of each custody disposition (dispo) per inmate.
  
- III. **PROCEDURE:** The following colored Avery dots are available from the facility supply personnel. The indicators are:
  - A. BLUE: Santa Rita Jail
  
  - B. YELLOW: Glenn E. Dyer Detention Facility (GEDDF)
  
  - C. RED: Pregnant/postpartum inmates and inmates with specific hazard and/or medical warning notes
