In summary, there were three inmate deaths:

- 1) Female inmate found in medical distress and later pronounced deceased. The cause of death was later determined to be cardiac arrhythmia and cardiac arrest due to acute methamphetamine intoxication.
- 2) Male inmate was found unresponsive and later pronounced deceased. The cause of death was later determined to be manual strangulation. The investigation in on-going.
- 3) Male inmate found hanging and later pronounced deceased. The cause of death was later determined to be asphyxia due to hanging.
